Finalist number one is Raquel Lett-Anderson from Decatur, Georgia. The mother of three, Raquel is the inventor of the Gabriel Feeding Pad.

"It's a new way of feeding your infant," she explained. The pad consists of a lightweight veil with a weighted back, so it doesn't slip. By lifting the veil, you can maintain mom-baby eye contact, but no one else can see what's going on under there.

The bottle-feeding attachment has a Velcro strap to hold bottles in place, and a strap to attach a pacifier or toys. And when you flip it over, it's a burping pad!
